**2008 OUTER LIGHT CLASSIC**  
ECSA Regatta Sponsored by the North Cove Yacht Club  
Third Leg of the “**Long Sand Shoal Series**”

- DATE:** Saturday, June 28, 2008
- FIRST WARNING:** 1100
- ELIGIBILITY:** Open to monohull yachts having a self-bailing cockpit, fixed berths, a galley and the ability to be self-supporting for a weekend cruise, as required by ECSA rules.
- STARTING LINE:** Between an orange flag on the committee boat and a yellow starting mark about 1 mile west of the Saybrook Breakwater Outer Light.
- COURSE:** Will run from 10 to 15 miles long weather permitting around government marks to be selected immediately prior to the race and Signaled in accordance with the race instructions.
- SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** Will be available at the North Cove Club clubhouse by 1800 on June 27th, and from the committee boat prior to the first warning.
- CLASSES AND HANDICAPPING:** Classes, including Cruising Canvas, will be set by the Race Committee. Yachts must have a currently valid PHRF-LIS certificate that will be used in handicapping.
- REPORTING:** Skippers are requested to hail the committee boat prior to the first warning.
- RULES:** Current Racing Rules of Sailing, this Notice, and Sailing Instructions.
- RESULTS AND PARTY:** Results will be announced at a post race party at North Cove Yacht Club after the race. Party starts at 1630 followed by results.
- DONATION AND ENTRY FORM:** Donations will be \$30 per yacht (USSA Members \$26). \$12 per party attendee in advance, or \$15 at the door. Entries will close Tuesday, June 24th at 1800 hours so please send your checks payable to NCYC with a copy of your PHRF certificate to:
