Fundraising Starts: At Kick-off Event, April 5, 2011 **Entries Close:** Thursday, August 25, 2011

Start Location: Approximately 3- miles west of the Connecticut River mouth in Old Saybrook, CT.

First Warning: 1100

For Charity: The Leukemia Cup Regatta is a charitable fund raising event for The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society (LLS). It combines social and racing activities for sailors, family and friends. On Friday night of race weekend, LLS will host a Captain's check-in with Reception (location/cost TBD). Saturday, PHRF racing will be run by the Duck Island Yacht Club (DIYC) Race Committee. CR914 racing will be hosted concurrently by North Cove Yacht Club (NCYC) with a separate notice to be directed towards CR914 racers. LLS and Brewer Pilots Point Marina (PPM) will host the Post Race Party including food/drink, music, raffles and live auction at PPM. Fundraising boats and individuals will receive incentives including the Leukemia Cup for the Top Fund Raising boat.

Rules: This regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012, the Sailing Instructions, and this Notice of Race. Rules Changes: The Sailing Instructions change the following rules: Rule 32, Rule 33, Rule 35, Rule 62.1(a), Rule 77-Appendix G, Race Signals-Postponement signaled ashore.

Courses: Will be selected just prior to each race by the Race Committee (RC), and signaled in accordance with the *Sailing Instructions*. The RC may conduct two or more races for some classes, weather permitting.

Sailing Instructions: Will be available at North Cove Yacht Club and Duck Island Yacht Club and online at www.northcoveyc.com and www.diyc.com no later than 24 hours prior to the first warning signal.

Classes: Several spinnaker and non-spinnaker classes based on PHRF-ECSA handicaps.

Eligibility: Entrants in handicap classes must have a current, valid PHRF-ECSA certificate on file in the ECSA/PHRF online database before Close of Entries, or submitted with the entry form.

Facilities: Limited free overnight moorings available in North Cove. Pick up a yellow-tagged mooring in North Cove. Brewer Pilots Point Marina will offer discounted transient dockage to registered captains for August 26th and 27th after April 5, by calling 860.399.7906.

Entry/Party Fees: Race Fee: \$36 per boat (\$50 for entries received at LLS after August 19).
Additional Fee \$5 per boat for entrants who are not USAA members.
Friday Night Regatta Check-In and Reception: (per person fee/location TBD).
Saturday Night Post-Race Party: \$20 per person in advance; \$25 at the door.

Scoring: Will be done by a PHRF-based "time-on-time" system and *RRS Appendix A*. No races will be excluded. This regatta is a qualifying race towards the Lloyd Phoenix Trophy and Long Sand Shoal Cup.

Results and Prizes: Results will be announced at the post-race party at Pilots Point Marina, Westbrook, CT. Prizes will be awarded to the top three finishers in each offshore class, and top five overall CR-914 racers.
